Killarney Hospital have been collaborating over the last three years on a project with the Prairie Mountain Health Region to renovate all of the Acute Care Washrooms. The renovated washrooms include making them wheelchair accessible with an enlarged door frame, installed new fixtures, flooring, counter tops, toilet, sink, bars, mirror and painting of complete room.
